2019 WEST BLOCKS - SEDIMENTARY SOILS DUNDEE HILLS - WILLAMETTE VALLEY - PINOT NOIR

The western blocks of our estate vineyard are west to south-west facing and are composed entirely of various sedimentary soil types. This section of our property consistently produces softly textured wines noted for dark brambly fruits and minerality.

Our fruit is triple hand-sorted and then fermented in micro-fermentation batches with native yeasts. A combination of gravity-flow winemaking and elegant integration of French Oak present a balanced and beautifully textured expression of world-class Oregon Pinot Noir.
